

THE STATEMENT OF the XXI-th International Contest of Children's Handwritten Book

1. Organization and conditions

- 1.1 The contest starts on **the 23-th of November 2017** in the Murmansk Regional Palace of Culture and Techniques After S.M.Kirov.
- 1.2 Preschoolers (strictly from 5 years old), pupils and students (up to 21 years), families, creative associations, study groups, studios, libraries, authors' collectives and collectives of authors, children's creativity centers, children's art schools, children's schools of art and other children's organizations all over the territories of the Barents region, Russia and other countries can participate in the contest.
- 1.3 The contest is presented by: poems, stories, fairy-tales, essays, travelers' notes with real or fantastic plot, legends, tales, and stories about the life of your family, your relatives, close and distant ancestors.
- 1.4 The following nominations appear in the competition:
 - Wonderful Stories of the Childhood (within declared in Russia a Decade Childhood Years 2018-2027);
 - My mast city;
 - Magic of the Northern Fairy Tale: Z.Topelius (Finland), S. Lagerlöf (Sweden), T. Egner(Norway);
 - My strong little nation (native people of the Kola Peninsula);
 - Let's become friends of nature (about taking good care of nature)
- 1.5 The working group formed of the founders of the contest solves the problems of organizing and carrying out of the contest.

1.6 A competitive book should have no more than A3 size and should include a cover, a title page, the content, the general information about the author and illustrator (surname, name, age, school, grade, the place of living, country and the contact telephone number). It should be safe for reading.

2. Summing up

- 2.1 The Contest is held in 2 stages:
 - a) in the areas (selection of the best works);
 - b) in the city of Murmansk, evaluation and jury, determination of the winners.
- 2.2 Summing up results of the contest will take place in Murmansk on **May 23**, **2018 at 13-00** at the **Young Writers' Festival** in the Assembly Hall of the Murmansk Region Children and Youth's Library.
- 2.3 Materials will be accepted by children's libraries from cities, towns and districts and will be passed to the Scientific and Methodic Department of the Murmansk Regional Children and Youth's library until March 1, 2018 after they have been looked through and selected at the local level.
- 2.4 Professional skills, originality, the quality of design are appreciated by the jury which consists of the representatives of the organizers.
- 2.5 Only winners of the contest in different nominations and their supporters are invited to the festival.
- 2.6 The Statement of the Contest and the Invitation to the Final Festival in Murmansk are the ground for sending participants to the Festival in Murmansk.
- 2.7 The sending side covers participants' journey to Murmansk tor the Final Festival and other expenses.
- 2.8 The competitive books are passed to the Museum of Children's Handwritten Book, which is based in the Murmansk Regional Children and Youth's library, with the granting of rights to use the competitive book for noncommercial purposes.

3. Awarding

- 3.1 The winners are awarded by:
 - The Grand –Prize of Murmansk Region Governor;
 - Prize «The Small Triumph»;
 - Audience Choice Award;
 - Diplomas and prizes from the prize fund of each founder

Participants are awarded with letters of thanks.

- 3.2 It is possible to represent the participant's territory in a festive procession of adults and school, students on **May 24** on the Day of Slavic Writing and Culture in Murmansk.
- 3.3 Other participants' awarding will take place in the Central children's libraries of the cities **after the Young** Writers' Festival.
